The Aids Walk brought out between 10 to 15 volunteers as course safety managers--event was smaller than last year and ended early.

None of our board showed up at the service event but the Potluck for our foreign visitors on Sat. night had a wonderful turnout. The Tuesday night reception and discussion was well attended and at least 8 members from our local group were there.

Catherine has been working with the mentor program and encouraged others of us to do so as well or encourage the membership to get involved.
