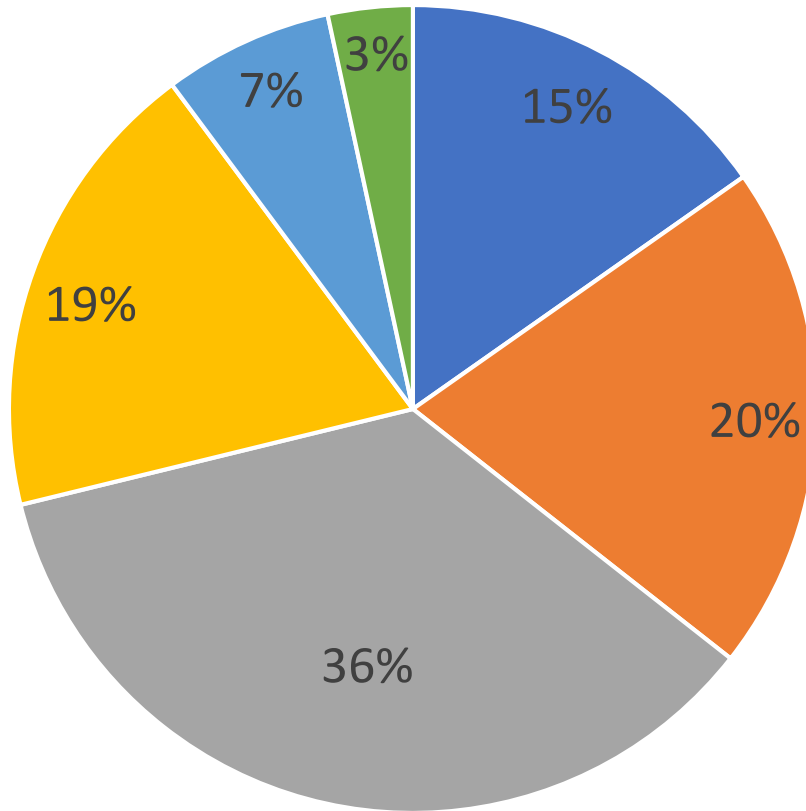

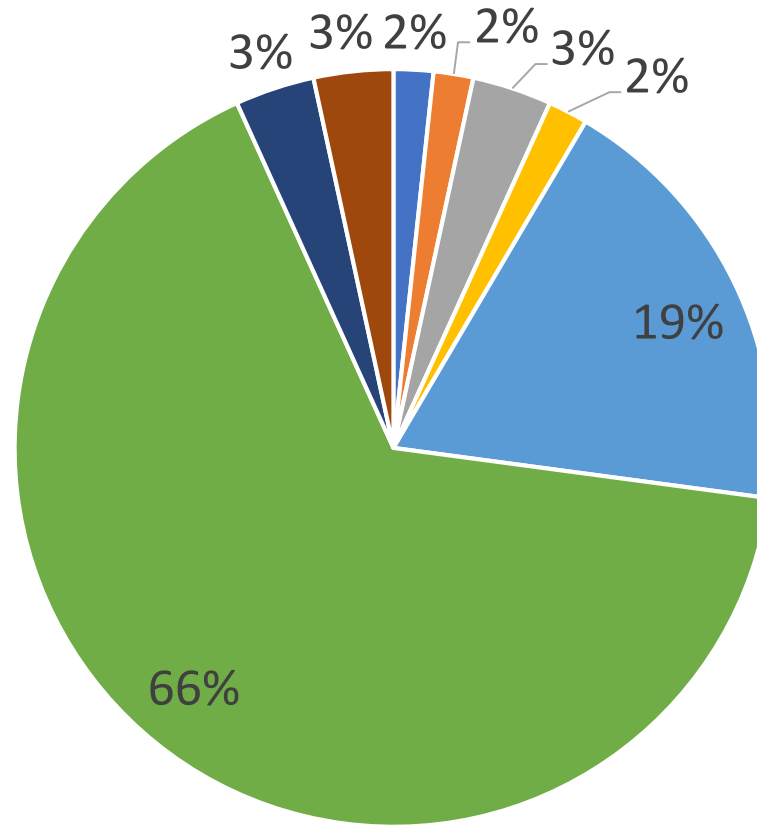

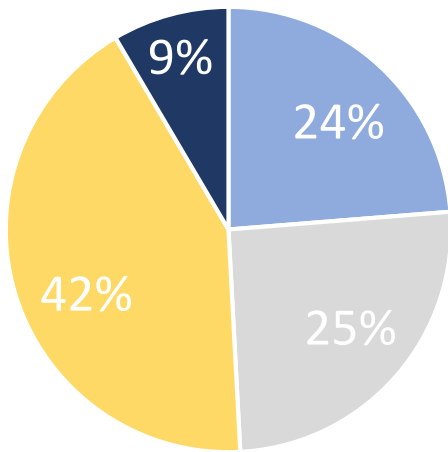
3. Where do you typically get information about SEAPAX activities/events?



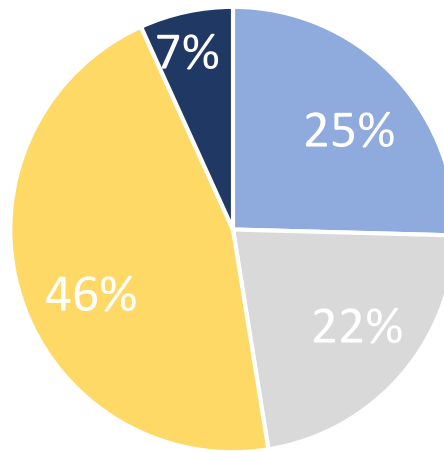

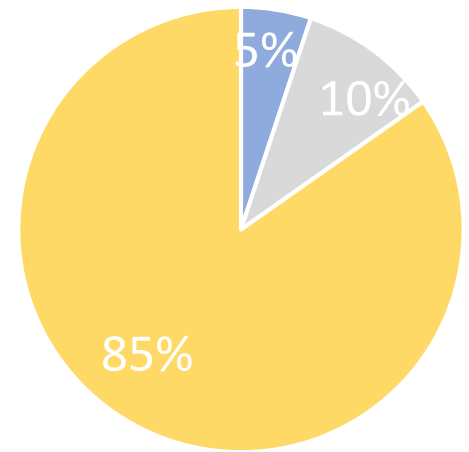
4. On average, how often do you visit the following sites?

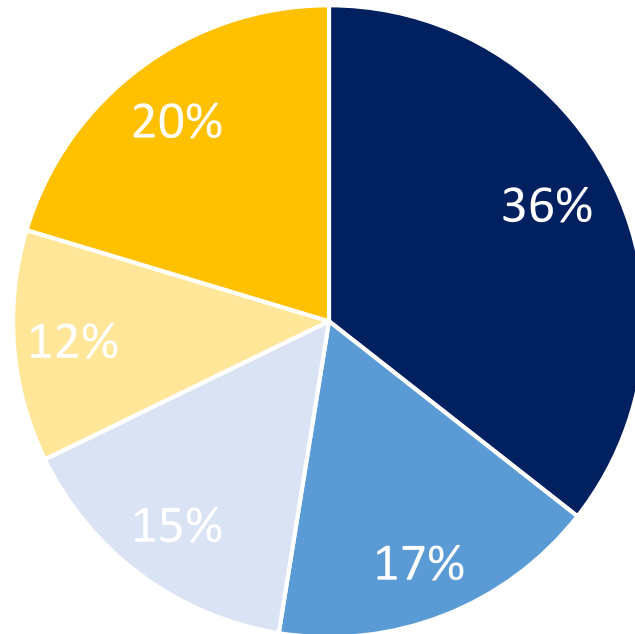

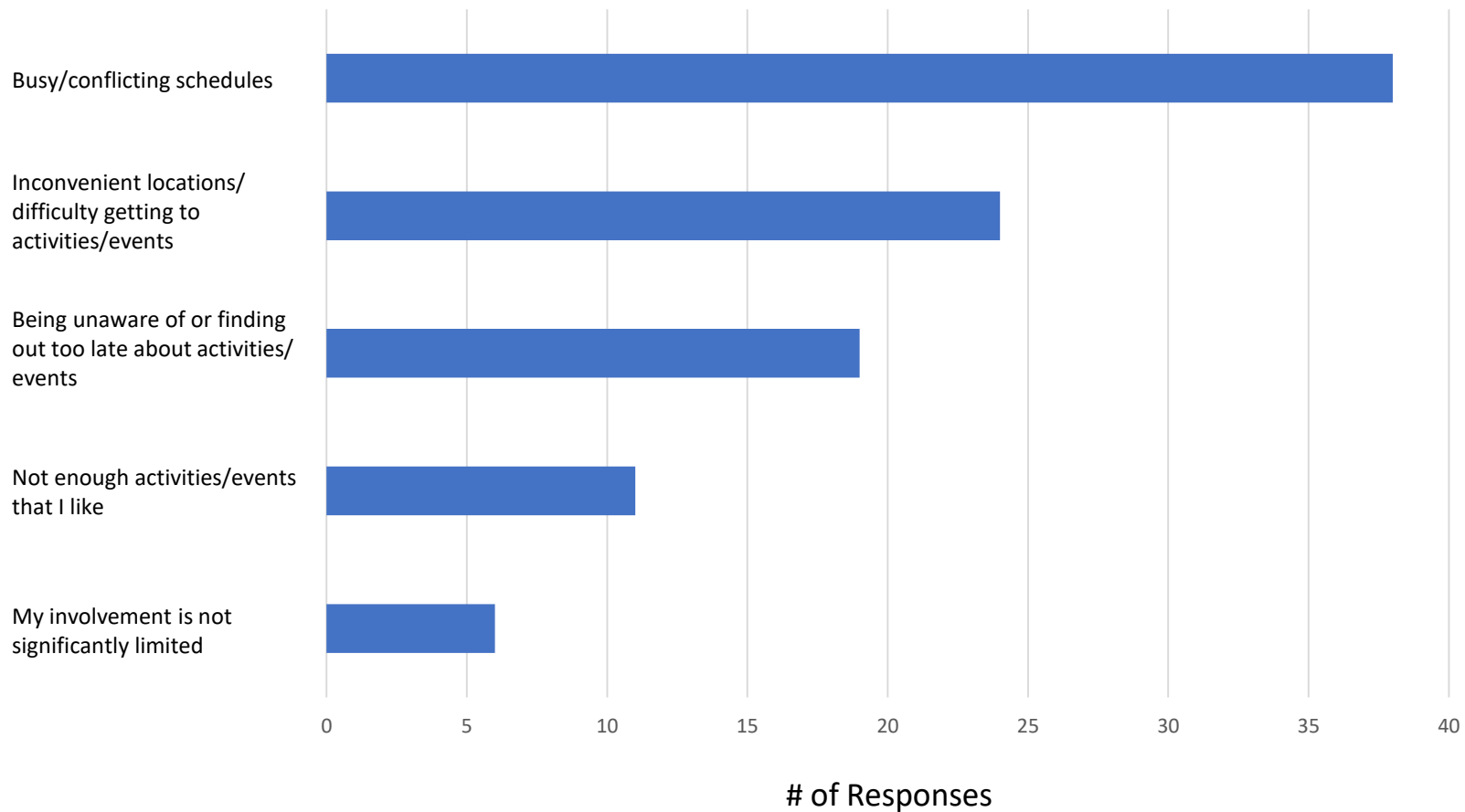

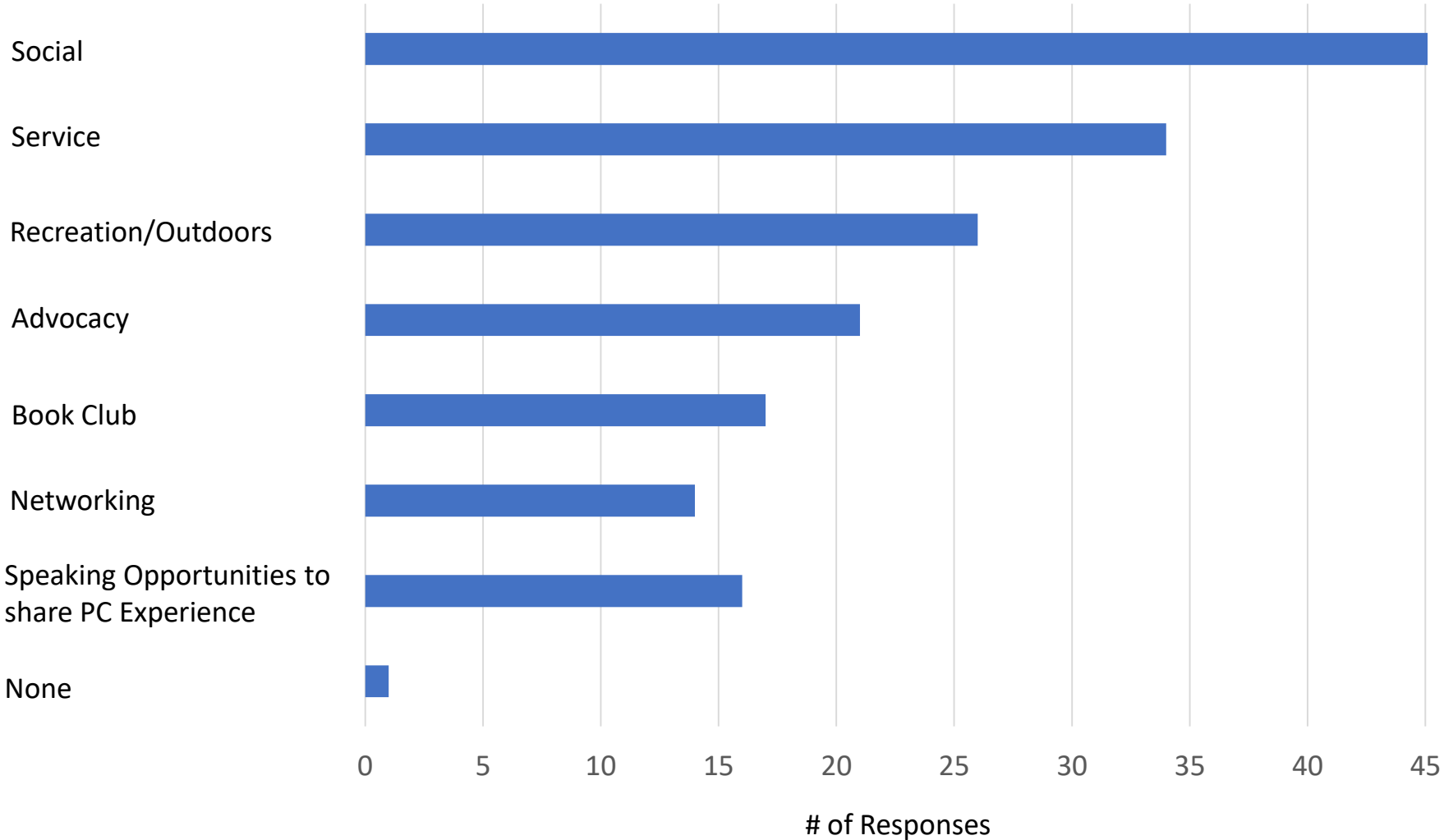

6. Do you feel like your involvement in SEAPAX activities/events is significantly limited due to any of the following?

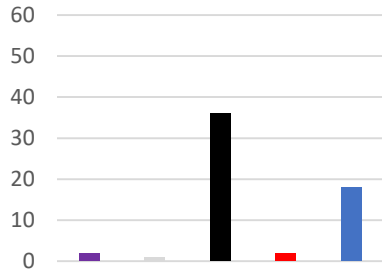


7. What activities/events do you typically like to participate in?

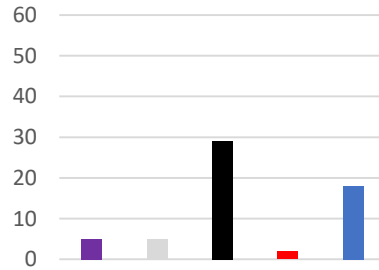


8. Would you like to see more or less of the following activities/events?

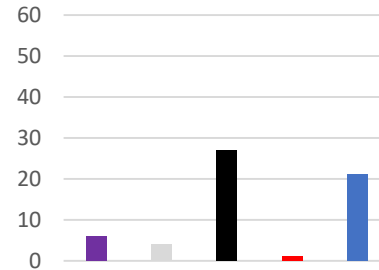

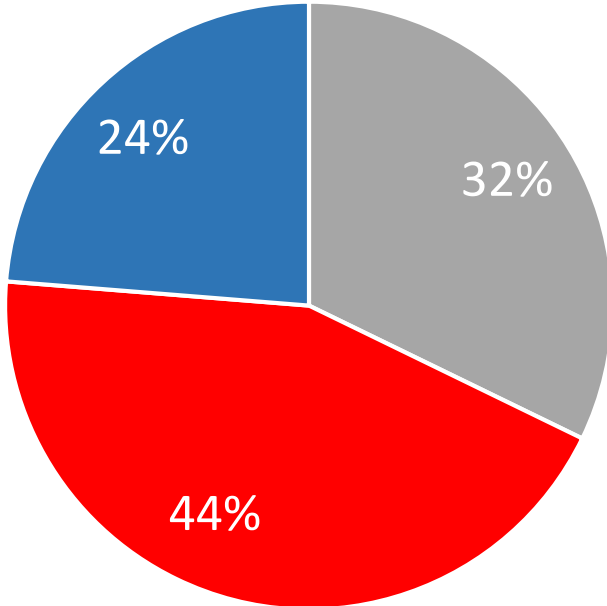
9. Are you aware that SEAPAX provides small grants to organizations to support community-based projects?

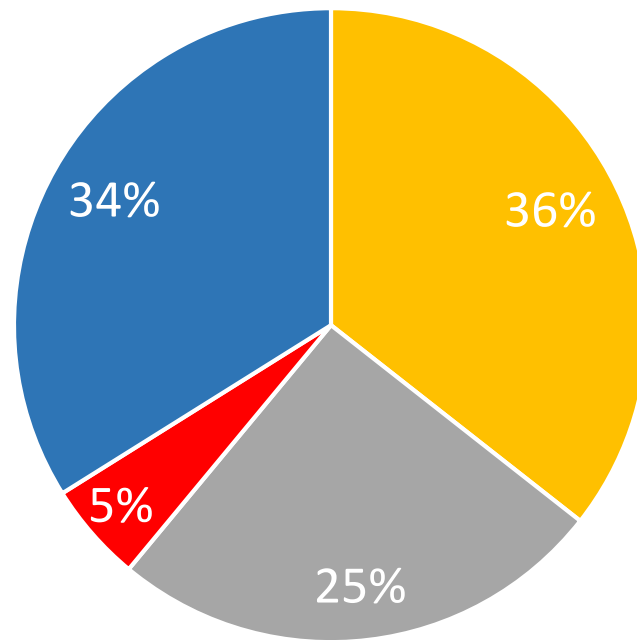

11. If you are aware of an organization that could use a small grant donation, would you be willing to assist the organization in completing a SEAPAX grant application?



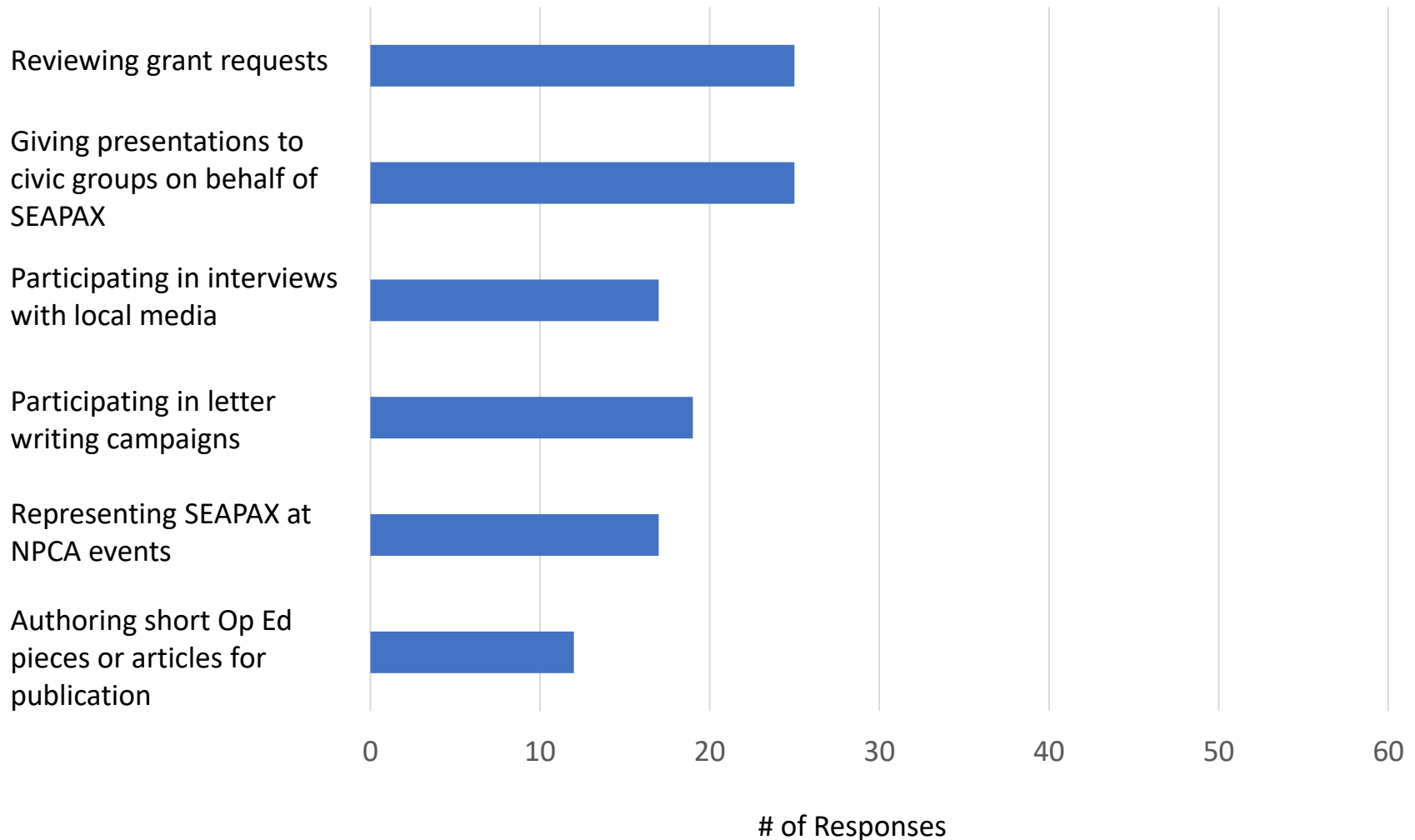

13. Comments

- I think it is important to have a balance between the social and advocacy aspects of the group. I also think it might be nice to team up with other local NW affiliates to hold a event, for example, if an RPCV author is only able to make it to one locale, perhaps the others can connect by computer.
- Please have more activities on the north side of Seattle (Ballard, Northgate). I won't drive into downtown on a week night.
- More big events. At least once a quarter know in advance. Not a month before.
- Gatherings in an easy to find place instead of homes. In the 80s we used a hall at Seattle Center and had large crowds up to 100.

13. Comments (cont'd)

- I would LOVE to be more involved in this community! I need dates about a month in advance - and waiting for the newsletter to show the dates in the same month limits my participation.
- I have had a few events in Kitsap county and would like to see more. I would organize outdoor and/or social activities over here, would love to see more Seattle folks enjoy a ferry ride over!
- There are many RPCVs outside the city of Seattle but there are almost never any SEAPAX activities outside the city. It makes it next to impossible for those of us who live in nearby locales to be able to participate.

13. Comments (cont'd)

- I would benefit from being reminded of upcoming events. Either through a Facebook event or emails coming out after the Newsletter each time to remind people that events are happening. It's easy for things to escape the radar, without a reminder about them.
- Great leadership team, need to get more regular members involved

Key Takeaways

- The newsletter is the primary means by which members are accessing SEAPAX-related information followed by Facebook
- Our Yahoo Group appears to be highly under-utilized, and potentially our website too
- About 1/3 of membership is relatively inactive regarding event participation
- Members are facing challenges getting to events and of getting information about planned activities ahead of time

Key Takeaways (cont'd)

- Members are generally happy with the types and number of planned activities, with the exception of service events, of which we could plan more
- Social events are the clear favorite of all our hosted activities, followed by service, recreation/outdoor and advocacy events
- The majority of members are aware of our grant activities, though most are not aware of any organizations that could use a grant
